

COPRH CON VIRTUAL POSTER GUIDELINES

Thank you for submitting a poster for presentation at the COPRH Virtual Conference to be held August 11 & 12, 2020.

The Virtual Poster Session at COPRH Con will provide an opportunity to share pragmatic research with the entire conference audience. COPRH will use a combination of recorded and live presentations to emulate the feel of a “real” poster session.

VIRTUAL POSTER SESSION GUIDELINES

PRAGMATIC RESEARCH CRITERION

All COPRH Con poster presentations must explicitly answer the question, “In what ways does the method(s) used in this project relate to planning or conducting pragmatic research?”

For COPRH Con, pragmatic research is defined as, “Research undertaken in the real world and with usual care and which is intended to help support a decision on whether – and in what context, population or setting – to deliver an intervention.”

PDF POSTER | Due July 24

Prepare your poster as a single page, PDF document. “Better poster” formats are permitted but should include sufficient detail for viewers to understand the methods used. The PDF version will be available for viewing prior to the COPRH Virtual Conference.

VIDEO PRESENTATION | Due July 24

Please create and submit a short video of your poster to accompany the Virtual Poster Session. You can record using Powerpoint with audio narration, or create your video using Prezi or other software. Videos are limited to 5 minutes and must be submitted in MP4 format.

FACILITATED LIVE DISCUSSION

Interactive discussions with poster presenters will be incorporated during the Virtual Poster Session on Tuesday, August 11. Your recorded video will be played at a specific time between 4:30 and 6:00 PM Mountain when you will be required to attend for real-time discussions with the conference audience.

We will confirm your scheduled time no later than August 4.
