

## HELPFUL SYNTAX IN TEXTBOXES

### [Personal Statement and/or Contributions to Science Sections ONLY]

#### FOR YOUR BIOSKETCH

To **BOLD** use <b>. Example: <b>emphasis</b> will result in **emphasis**

OR use <strong>. Example: <strong>I really like emphasis</strong> will result in **I really like emphasis**

To *ITALICIZE* use <i>. Example: <i>voice</i> will result in *voice*

OR use <em>. Example: <em>way to italicize</em> will result in *another way to italicize*

To UNDERLINE use <ins>. Example: <ins>stress</ins> will result in stress

To have a HEADER use <h1>, <h2>, <h3>, <h4>, <h5>, or <h6>. The headers will range in size depending on the number used (1 is the largest, 6 is the smallest). Example: <h1>Step 1</h1>

To Superscript use: <sup>. Example: <sup>1</sup> will result in <sup>1</sup>

To Subscript use: <sub>. Example: <sub>2</sub> will result in <sub>2</sub>

To **HIGHLIGHT** use <mark>. Example: <mark>highlight me</mark> will result in **highlight me**

To make a paragraph use <p> or <br>.

Example 1 <p>The beginning and the end.</p> will result in

The beginning and the end

as a paragraph.

Example 2 <br> to create a line break between paragraphs.

To make a list

Use the following for unordered list with bullets <ul> and then <li>

Use the following for ordered listed with numbers <ol> and then <li>

To make an emdash ( – ). Use the following &mdash;. Example: fun&mdash;fun

will look like fun–fun
