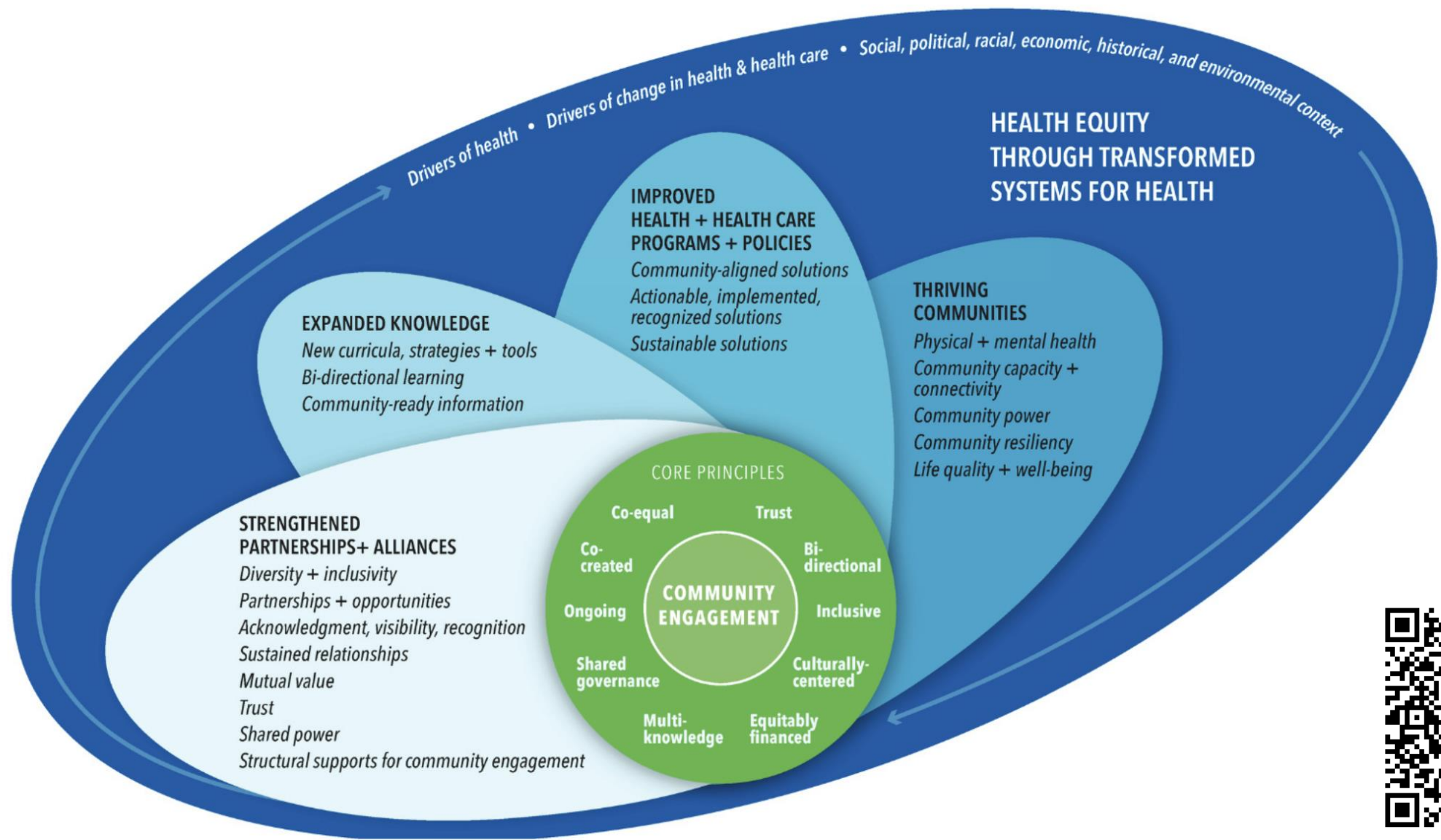

# Why do we need to talk about sustaining partnerships?

  - “We wish to improve the health and wellbeing of recent immigrants to NE Colorado”

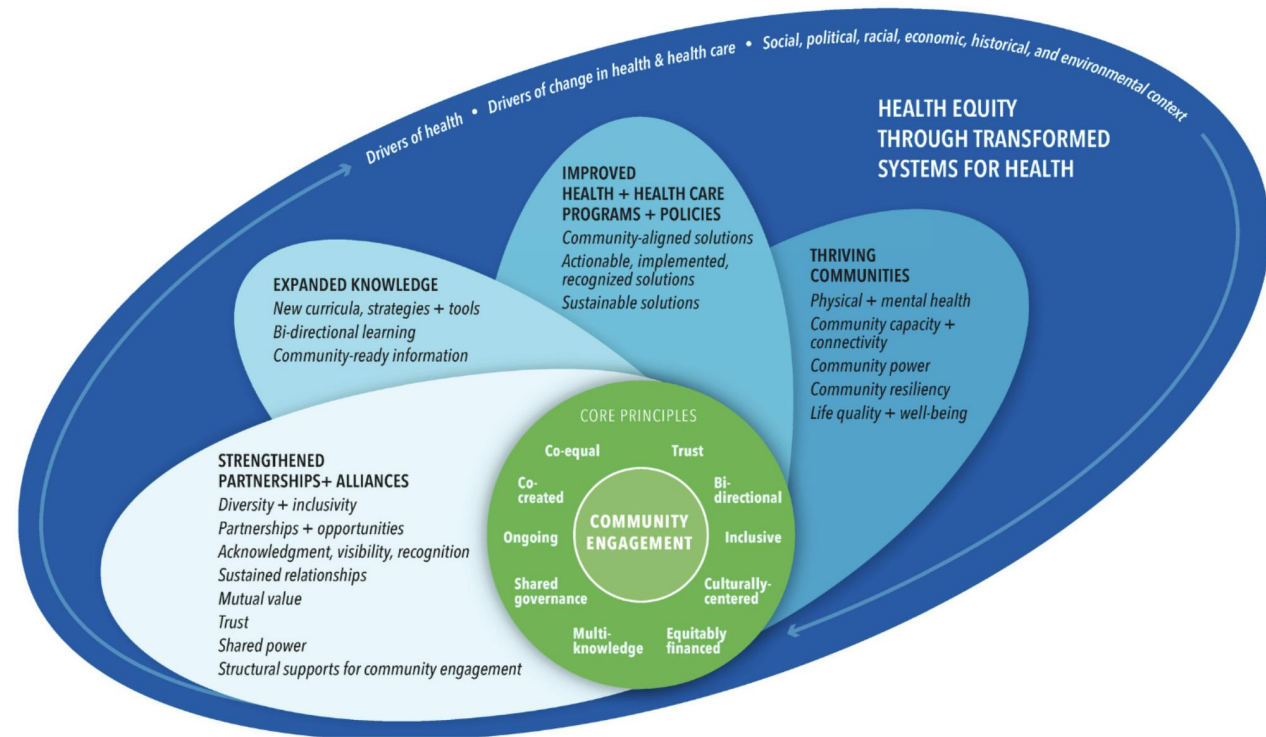
